



ISO27001 Fact Sheet

ISO/IEC 27001 is the international standard for information security for Improved Risk Management.

The ISO 27001 is the assessment and management of risk. To achieve this certification, a company must design and implement an Information Security Management System (ISMS) containing safeguards to ensure the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of every solution they deliver.

Confidentiality: information is only disclosed with the appropriate and authorised parties.

Integrity: information stored and used is accurate.

Availability: Information is available and accessible when it is required to help deliver services.

What does it mean for us?

- Have optimised the Confidentiality, Integrity, and Availability of Information Asset.
- Are in compliant with International Security Operational Practice.
- Have put in place, controls and added security layers designed to deter and avoid internal and external threats.
- Have standardised our operations, thereby leading to improved internal efficiency and response time.
- Have put in place redundant Infrastructures that are designed to realise fail-over.
- Have deployed controls targeted towards realising 99.9% uptime and incident-free.
- We have assessed risks and mitigated the impact of a breach.
- Ensured information is accurate and can only be modified by authorised users.
- Been independently assessed to an international standard based on industry best practices.
